Today, significantly, the war has increased the number of immigrants. The flood of immigrants to European countries has caused the balance and order of these countries to be disrupted most of the time. In recent years, the term crisis has been used for this situation. The European migration crisis is generally referred to as the political, social, and economic consequences that have arisen following the arrival of asylum seekers in Europe since 2015. This has had different results in the social-political arena of European countries. Although the appearance of these immigrants has decreased in recent years, in general, the discourse of anti-immigrant and xenophobia shows unprecedented growth in the public opinion of European citizens. For example, far-right parties in countries such as Austria and Italy, together with populist politicians in Central European countries, have made the most of this opportunity and have been able to achieve significant positions. The anti-immigrant debate is tied to criticism of Brussels and opposition to the European Union. It should be noted that the experience of European countries in facing this phenomenon is different, and according to the geographical conditions, each of them has a different view of this crisis. Despite this, most countries generally want to prevent the entry of asylum seekers into their country. The recent efforts of the heads of European countries to reach a comprehensive solution to face this crisis have not been successful, and many pillars of the European Union, including free movement and the Schengen system, have been exposed to reform and strengthen the supervision and control on the borders. The level of disagreement among the leaders of the European countries in this matter is so great that it has brought some countries in the south and center of the Union, which are on the path of the arrival of asylum seekers, closer to each other against Germany and France. According to the data, the most significant volume of the arrival of asylum seekers to Europe happened in 2015. A total of 1,015,078 asylum seekers entered this continent. As mentioned, this process continues due to the crisis of war, and removing or ignoring this issue can have wider human consequences, and in general, this seems impossible. Three points, more than All with immigration, in the destination countries, the crisis is more: 1) the capital and budget that the governments must consider for the immigrants. 2) due to the lack of land and space, the problem of marginalization is increasing. Therefore, the statistics of insecurity, delinquency, unemployment, and class gap are increasing more and more. 3) Spreading unemployment statistics in destination countries. And produce and sell their native art here. On the other hand, governments can finally train these people according to their local and even national needs through non-governmental and private organizations such as NGOs and technical and vocational schools. Finally, after acquiring the skills necessary to provide these spaces for living and working. In this way, these people will have both human character and citizenship, and they will not be a burden on the country they immigrated to in terms of income.
